Internet

The Internet is an exciting and powerful tool for students to research information for both academic assignments as well as their own personal interests. As Part of our curriculum, pupils have controlled access to the Internet and learn how to use libraries, database and information sources on a wide variety of topics.

We recognise that some inappropriate material on the Internet may be accessed intentionally or by accident. To guard against this we use a filtered service provided by Websense which automatically blocks student access to inappropriate material. We teach students the importance of responsible use of web and e-mail as well as providing basic rules to maintain the privacy of students. At all time, *pupils must agree to follow the Rule for Responsible Internet Use* summarised at the end of this letter.

To ensure the privacy of your child, the Knowsley school site will make sure:

- A student's last name is never published
- Permission to publish work will always be gained from the student
- If a contact person is needed for a project, this will be the teacher, not the student.
- No identifying material will be posted on the Internet (such as personal phone numbers, home addresses, and individual pictures with the student's first and last names.)
- If class pictures are posted, it may mention names but not which individuals are standing where in the picture.
- Class picture will generally include at least three or more students
- If individual pictures are posted of students, it will not include their name.
- Personal web pages will not be published from school. Where a web page is published, it will be based on the classroom curriculum.

To enable your son/daughter to use and contribute to the Internet please read and discuss the Rule for Responsible Internet Use and return the attached form.

RULES FOR RESPONSIBLE USE OF THE SCHOOL'S INTERNET

These rules apply at all times, in and out of school hours, whilst using school equipment. If you parents have signed and returned the permission form, Internet access will be provided for you to conduct research and communicated with others but only on the understanding that you agree to follow this code.

THE CODE

You must:

\checkmark	Only access site that are appropriate for use in school. This also applies outside lesson time.
\checkmark	Be aware that your actions on the Internet can be seen by others.
\checkmark	Be careful of what you say to others and how you say it. Never give your name, home address,
	telephone numbers or any personal information about yourself to others to any strangers you
	write to or talk with on the Internet.
\checkmark	Treat others as they would expect to be treated. E.g. show respect and be polite.
\checkmark	Respect copyright and trademarks. You cannot use the words or pictures that you see on an
	Internet site without giving credit to the person that owns the site. You must not copy rext or
	picture from the Internet and hand it in to your teacher as your own work.
\checkmark	Notify an adult immediately, if by accident, you encounter materials which violate the rules of
	appropriate use.

You must not:

Х	Send, access or display offensive messages, language or pictures.
Х	Download files without the prior permissions of your teachers. File could have viruses that
	damage the computer equipment as well as causing delays for other users.
Х	Complete questionnaires or subscriptions form for yourself or others. These may ask for
	personal information that will affect your privacy.
Х	Intentionally waste limited resources such as disk space or printing capacity.
Х	Use a computer to harm other people or their work
Х	Damage the computer or the network in any way.
Х	Interfere with the operation of the network by installing illegal software, shareware, or
	freeware.
Х	Share your password with another person.
Х	Do not trespass in another's folders, work, or files.

Please note:

User areas on the school network will be closely monitored and staff may review your files and communications to maintain system integrity.

Failure to follow the code will result in loss of access. Students needs to be aware that some material on the Internet is protected by copyright laws and where this has been infringed, external agencies may become involved.

Consent for Video/Digital Recordings of Performances

I give permission for the school to use video/digital recordings of my son/daughter when taking part in performances, work led projects and to appear in recordings of school trips.

I also give permission to the school to sell copies of the video recording and/or digital photographs to other families, carers and parents.

Children have the opportunity to attend 'Relax Kids' sessions which complement the government's Healthy Schools initiative and are based on a range of physical activities. The sessions include:

Movement and Dance	Games	
Stretches	Breathing Exercises	
Peer Massage	Positive Thinking	
• Listening to specially written stories which help children to use their imagination to relax		
 Use of background music and safe aromatherapy oils to scent the room 		

Peer massage involved children massage a partner in a very controlled way. It will involved only a few minutes in massage hands or in drawing shapes on each other's backs. Children remain fully clothed during the session, wearing their school uniform. The Learning Mentor or teacher will demonstrate the message techniques on themselves or on another adult and never on a child.

These sessions take place in our Calm Room which has been specifically developed for use by all children in school and provides a quiet and relaxing space. The relaxation sessions help children to develop their self-confidence, concentration and creativity.

No special clothing or equipment is used. There will be a rolling programmed of peer massage, so all children will attend a peer massage session at some point during their education at Sylvester.
