Nursery Class

In Nursery the story 'Pete the Cat and his 4 Groovy Buttons' has been our focus. We have been learning all about the number 4: counting sets of objects, finding numerals and making sets of 4. On Tuesday for snack we made our own groovy buttons by cutting bread into circle shapes. In the craft area we printed with different sized circles and drew around them to make our own groovy button patterns! In the home corner we had number 4 picnics. We could invite 4 friends to play and each had a cup, plate and bowl making 4 of each item in total. We have enjoyed learning a new number song too: 5 little snowmen standing in a line. For our fine motor activity, we threaded buttons and for our mark making we practised drawing circles to create our own Pete the Cat pictures! We learned that squares and rectangles have 4 sides so made some shapes pictures. We looked at the artist Mondrian and created our own artworks in his style. The weather this week has been great for exploring wind! We made windy sticks and flew them around outside. Some of them blew away and flew over the school roof!

Reception Class

This week we have started our new Literacy Tree Text, 'The Magic Paintbrush' by Julia Donaldson. The children arrived to class to find our very own special paintbrush. We talked about the meaning of the words 'wealthy' and 'poor'. Together we thought about useful things we could paint and this led us to think about the difference between things we 'want' and things we 'need'. In Maths we have been exploring 'Capacity'. We have been using the language of full, empty, half full and half empty. We then explored different containers and what we thought would hold the most. In Phonics we have started to look at some 'red words' which can also been known as 'tricky words'. These are words that we are not able to sound out as they do not make sense e.g. to, no and go. Have a listen to the tricky word song to help your child.
