Nursery Class

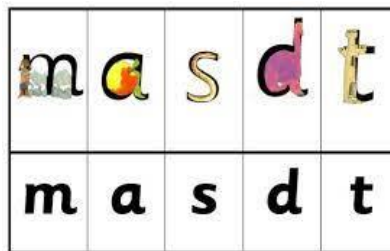

Reception Class

This week the children have loved learning some sounds in Phonics. The children have been fantastic and have worked really hard to develop their letter formation. These are the rhymes we teach the children to help with their letter formation.



m: Maisie mountain mountain

a: around the apple and down the leaf

s: slither down the snake

d: round the dinosaurs bottom, up his tall neck and down to his feet

t: down the tower, across the tower

Our school uses a Phonics Scheme called Read, Write, Inc to teach the children to read and write. They have lots of resources available online to demonstrate to parents how their child learns so you may find it useful to have a look at.
