Nursery Class

In Nursery this week we have continued learning about the number 4 and finding out the different ways we can make 4, e.g. 2 and 2, 3 and 1 etc. We played a 'frog on a log' counting game to help with this concept and also played a ladybird number game for counting and number recognition practise. A few of our children have been talking about PJ Masks so in the craft area we practised our cutting skills and made some masks of our own! In the garden we have played a skittles game using empty bottles and bean bags and have had lots of fun role playing PJ Masks, building dens and cars to play in! For our mark making activities we did 'squiggle while you wiggle' and drew a simple ladybird using lines and circles. On Thursday we did some body awareness. The children had to sit and listen very carefully, following instructions and copying actions. The children were amazing at this! A huge well done to everyone!
