Nursery Class

In Nursery this week we have continued to learn about the number 6 with the help of the story 'Six Dinner Sid'. We counted out sets of cat treats (play buttons and pompoms!) into numbered cat bowls matching the number of treats to the corresponding numerals. We also had a currant bun shop and practised counting out 6 pennies to pay for them.

As part of our Science work we have continued to look after our plants and seeds...and we finally have one shoot starting to grow! We have looked at daffodils, talked about the names of their different parts (stem, petal, flower, leaf and cup) and made some observational drawings. Another mark making activity we did was practise tracing or copying our names. As we are still thinking about the story Jack and the Beanstalk, we had beans on toast for snack! For World Book Day we did lots of reading of our favourite stories and did some, Elmer and Gruffalo craft! Reception Class

This week in Reception we have had a big focus on reading books. We talked about how we can have favourite books that we love to read more than once and how sometimes it is nice to read a different book. The children loved bringing their books into school for World Book Day and we read as many as we possibly could!

We have continued to explore our focus text, 'The Extraordinary Gardener'. We talked about our outdoor area and how we could use this space for planting and growing. We explored a range of different seeds and talked about what we thought they might grow into. Mrs Blackhall helped us to plant them outside in the garden!

In Maths we have been exploring 3D shapes. We have looked at their properties and their names. We made links with everyday objects e.g. a cereal box being made in the shape of a cuboid.
