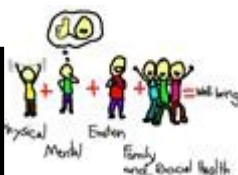
### School PE Tops

### Upcoming Elections

Elections will be taking place in Knowsley on Thursday 2 May 2024. This includes local elections as well as the election of the Combined Authority Mayor and the Merseyside Police and Crime Commissioner.

To vote in these elections, you must be registered to vote by 11.59pm on Tuesday 16 April 2024. If you've never registered, have moved address or changed your name, register to vote online at [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote)

Once you are registered, there are a number of different ways you can vote:-

**Postal vote:** If you are not already registered for a postal vote, you need to do so by 5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024

You can apply online for a postal vote by visiting the Government's website. You will be asked to provide your National Insurance Number.

If you are already registered for a postal vote, you don't need to do anything. You will be contacted by the Election Team when your postal vote is due for renewal.

**Voting by Proxy:** If you are unable to vote in person and would like someone to vote on your behalf, you can apply for a proxy vote. The deadline for applications is 5pm on Wednesday 17 April.

**Voting in person at a Polling Station:** If you are voting in person on Thursday 2 May, please remember to bring a valid photo ID with you. If you don't have a valid ID, you can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate up until 5pm on Wednesday 24 April. Apply online on the Government's website.

Pop-up MMR clinics are taking place in Knowsley to help get as many children as possible vaccinated against Measles, Mumps and Rubella.
