Children's University Graduation

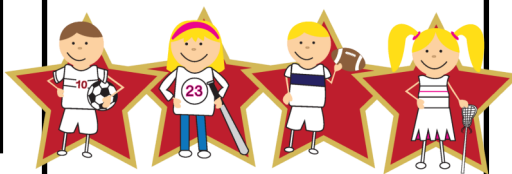
This year's Children's University Graduation will be taking place at Hope University on Monday 17th June (pm), so please put the date in your diary.
