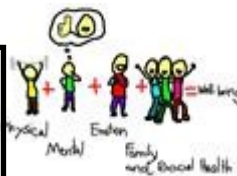
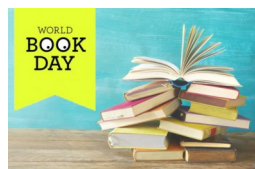

Parents' Evening

Our next Parents' Evenings will be taking place on Tuesday 19th and Wednesday 20th March for all classes from Reception to Year 6 with the exception of Year 1/2 and 5 who will have their parents' evening on the 19th and 25th March.

We are now using a new booking system called SchoolCloud which is used right across the country.

The new booking system relies on the data that we have in our school management information system. SchoolCloud will authenticate the user based on their first name, surname, child's first name, child's surname and date of birth.

If the data that is input by the user does not match what we have on our system then it will not allow you to log in and make a booking. If this occurs, then please call the school office so we can verify the details and ensure that it matches correctly so a booking can then be made.

The last date for making bookings for Parents' Evening is 17th March.
