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Our Nursery children have been reading the story of 'Little Red Riding Hood'. They have enjoyed listening to the story and joining in with the repeated language. The children have enjoyed exploring the story sack and retelling the story using props and dressing up as the different characters.

Our Reception children have been learning about sharing. We have been looking at this both from a mathematical point of view e.g. sharing an amount of counters between two people and also from a friendship point of view e.g. sharing the toys fairly with a friend. We have continued to think about words that rhyme and writing rhyming phrases e.g. a cat in a hat, a dog on a log and a car in a star.

Why don't you try this at home? (Magic Moment)

Magic Moments are your way of sharing something magical your child does at home. This allows the teachers to evidence children's achievements at home as well as in school, showing that we are working together to support your child. You can use the ideas below or perhaps you have spotted them doing something different that you would like to share with us. Please use Class Dojo to share your child's Magic Moment with us.

Nursery: Have a go at telling your grown up the story of Little Red Riding Hood. Can you remember some key lines from the story? E.g. Oh Grandma what big eyes you have!

Reception: Can you share different amounts by 2 (you could do this with toys or sweets etc.) e.g. 10 shared by 2. We often use phrases such as one for me and one for you.

Reminders:

As we enjoy the warmer weather please remember to put sun cream on your child. You may also want to send your child in with a sun cap that they can wear when playing outside in the garden.

Please ensure children have appropriate footwear on for school. We know lots of the children are wearing their summer uniform but children should not be wearing sandals as this would not provide appropriate protection to their feet when playing in the garden and on or alongside the bikes and climbing equipment. School shoes are still part of our school uniform.
