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Another fun week had in our Early Years base. The children in Nursery have been practising their counting using the Nursery Rhyme 1,2,3,4, 5 Once I Caught a Fish Alive. In continuous provision the children have made some glittery and sparkly rainbow fish.

The children in Reception Class have started their phonics sessions this week. So far the children have been practising reading and writing the sounds m,a,s,d and t. Even with just these five sounds lots of words can be made. Encourage your child to recognise these sounds and try to sound out words such as mad, mat, sad, Sam and sat.


Take Care Everybody and Stay Safe.

Why don't you try this at home? (Magic Moment)

Magic Moments are your way of sharing something magical your child does at home. This allows the teachers to evidence children's achievements at home as well as in school, showing that we are working together to support your child. You can use the ideas below or perhaps you have spotted them doing something different that you would like to share with us. Please use Class Dojo to share your child's Magic Moment with us.

Nursery: Have a go at finding your name from a selection of names. The children do this in school as part of their self-registration.

Reception: Practice writing these sounds and use the rhymes to help.



Letter Formation Rhymes:

m=Maisie mountain mountain.

a=Around the apple and down the leaf.

s=Slither down the snake.

d=Down the town and across the tower.

Reminders:

Your child can bring a pair of wellies into school to leave here for them to use when playing outdoors in the garden (they will need these to play out on rainy days).
