This week the Nursery children have been looking at holidays and some of the different things you may put into your suitcase. They have continued to find out about Italy and have looked at some photographs of famous places in Italy. Both the Nursery and Reception children loved playing outside with a giant beach ball and used it to explore how they could make it move using different parts of their body.

Our Reception children have been working so hard on improving their handwriting and number formation. They have been trying to ensure their letters sit on the line. We have also been doing lots of extra reading and making sure we have consolidated what we already know ready for our move into Y1.

On Friday we have a transition afternoon planned for the children moving up from Reception into Year 1. The children will spend time with their new class teacher and in their new classroom. We are also sending home transition booklets which will allow your child to look at photographs of their new teachers/classrooms and also find out some key information. Children moving from Nursery to Reception you should have received an email with how transition looks for your child.
