


**WEDNESDAY**

Pick your favourite song and practice some 'Squiggle while you Wiggle'. Focus on circles and straight lines.

Create your own minibeast playdough! Create 'bee playdough' using yellow food colouring, black pom-poms, pipe cleaners and googly eyes. Create 'ladybird playdough' using red playdough, black buttons and pom-poms.

**THURSDAY**

Go on a mini beast hunt in your garden. Observe and talk about what you can see. Model and support language talking in sentences.

Place a set of objects under a magic cloth. Reveal and ask your child to make marks to represent how many they can see e.g. 3 cups = 3 marks. Try 1-3 to start then go higher.

Create a spider's web outside on the floor using sticky tape. Challenge the children to walk on tiptoes around the web without falling off it.

## FRIDAY

Today it is BIG DRAW in class. Have some fun with your mark making. Use a big roll of paper to draw on! Paint with sticks! Do some under the table drawing!
