



# Year 1

## Autumn 1

### English

#### Cave Baby

Children will use the text to act out parts of the story and then use this to help them write sentences and simple narratives. The children will begin to read their writing to check that it makes sense.

#### Naughty Bus

The children will love the excitement of Naughty Bus causing chaos in their classroom!

In addition to English, children will have phonics lessons daily and read with an adult to develop skills such as fluency, pace, and comprehension.

### French

Children will learn greetings, how to say 'my name is' and numbers in French.

### Computing

Children will be taught the different ways of being online and learn how to be safe while on them.

### Science

#### Humans

The children will learn humans are animals. The children will learn the names of human body parts and about the 5 senses, sight, hearing, taste, touch, and smell.

### Physical Education

Children will learn skills in PE; they will learn how to use space, roll and throw a range of balls and objects, using roll, underarm and overarm throwing techniques.

### Religious Education and World Views

The children will look at two different religions; Christianity and Hinduism, and the symbolism of 'hands' within these religious practices to understand how do people show care and commitment?

### Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education

Children will learn about the importance of families and relationships. In this unit, the children will challenge gender stereotypes.

Children will explore their locality, Huyton. Through fieldwork they will look at surrounding places and plot them on a map. Children will sort local features into human and physical features.

This unit helps children to understand and use different line types and mark-making techniques in drawing, and experiment with various media

Children will produce an under-water themed performance incorporating instrumental, vocal and body sounds.
