### Send for a Superhero

The children will be engaging with the text; using adjectives to describe characters, and creating 'Wanted' posters to help catch the baddies! They will create their own comic!

### Julian Is a Mermaid

The children will enjoy listening to music to help them connect to the movement of a mermaid and other sea creatures. They will write their own three-verse poem.

## Science

Seasons We will explore the season of Spring and how it changes our environment and weather.

Plants The children will be taught how seeds grow into plants and what plants need to grow. They will identify and describe the basic structure of common plants including trees. Finally, the children will grow their own plants and discuss the changes.

## History

Children will learn about significant people, including explorers, are remembered in lots of different ways. Some explorers have places named after them. Some have their pictures on stamps or there might be statues to commemorate them.

## Computing
