English: Reading (Daily)	<p>Complete the activities that have been set on Reading Eggs. The children have been given their unique login name and password. Press the login button in the top right corner and enter their information to log them in. Once the children have completed the set activities they can navigate their way through the activities.</p>					
English: Writing	<p>Last week 'Naughty Bus' came into our classroom and made a big mess, knocking over our things and spilling beans. This week the children will write a letter to naughty bus explaining that we cannot do this in school and that we have to say sorry and behave better. Please talk to your child about our school rules 'be ready, be respectful, be safe' and ask the children if naughty bus was being these things. Ask the children how they felt when naughty bus messed the classroom and ask how it might have made Miss Hardaker and Mrs Stanley feel. What did we have to do to fix the situation? Ask the children to make notes of these ideas. Look at pictures of letters on the internet and look as what we need – who the letter is going to, an introduction of why we are writing the letter and who the letter is from. The children can then begin to start writing their letters to Naughty bus, explaining that we were not happy, that he broke our school rules, what he should be doing instead and who the letter is from.</p>					
Phonics (Daily)	<p>The children have started to learn about diagraphs (two letters that make one sound) and trigraphs (three letters that make one sound). They have been looking at ay, ee, igh, ow, oo. The children have also been learning tricky words. Please revise these words Children can work through the levels on 'Phonics play' which is an interactive phonics game on the</p>

English: Spelling	<p>Children to practise their letters and words throughout the week and complete a test on Friday. When practising the spellings with the children, provide the word in a sentence so the children can gain a concept of the word and how it is used.</p> <p>The spellings are – job, jug, will, win, van, vet, mix, box</p>
English: Handwriting	<p>Practise the letters – x, a, k, h Practise the words – he, she, the, I. The children are being introduced to writing their letters cursively; please promote this with the children when they are practising their handwriting.</p>
Maths – Arithmetic (Daily)	<p>Practise number formation (writing numbers correctly) with the numbers 1 – 10. Practise counting forwards and backwards, encourage the children to count something while doing this (eg steps, jumps, claps). Ask the children what is one more than a number or one less than a number.</p>
Maths	<p>Complete the set activities on MyMaths. The children have been given a letter detailing how to log in, the school's log in details and their unique login name and password. Follow the steps on the letter that was sent home to log in. The children should complete these activities with the supervision of an adult.</p>
Science	<p>We are starting to learn about the human body. We will be exploring all the different parts of the body through a game of Simon says.</p>
History	<p>As it is Remembrance Day this week, we will be looking at why we remember this day and what we are remembering during our minutes silence. Please go through the PowerPoint and make some poppies with your child.</p>
PSHE	<p>We have been focusing on kindness and what we can do to be kind to our classmates, family and strangers. We are currently working on creating 21 acts of kindness as there are 21 children in our class. Discuss with the children how they can be kind to their family and get them to complete an act of kindness.</p>
PE	<p>For physical education please play bingo!</p>
