English

Billy and the beast

Children will have the opportunity to write 'a day in the life of' in the form of a summery, emails to give advice, recipes and then create their own version of a 'Billy and the beast' story.

Dragon post

Children write a letter in role asking for help and then a letter of advice to help, children find out how to look after a dragon and write instructions for dousing a dragon.

Mathematics

Place Value within 100 (within 10 YI)

- Sort, count and represent objects.
- Count forwards and backwards.
- Count one more and one less.
- Count using one to one correspondence.
- Compare objects and numbers.
- Ordinal numbers
- The number line.

Addition and Subtraction within 100. (Within 10 YI)

- Part whole models.
- The addition Symbol.
- Addition facts
- Number bonds within 100. (YI within 10)

Physical Education

During this term the children will be learning about fundamental games and skills needed for a range of games, We will also learn about basketball.

Science

Seasons

We will explore the season of Autumn and how it changes our environment and weather. We will collect data to use to compare future seasons.

Humans

The children will learn the names for the parts of the body and begin to explore their five senses. Children will complete scientific enquiries to test the information they have learnt.

Computing

Children will be taught the different ways of being online and learn how to be safe while on them.

French

Children will learn greetings and emotions to hold a simple conversation

Art and Design

Children will use string and chalk to draw lines, colour neatly using different media and develop observational skills.

Geography

During the first term the children will develop their geographical knowledge and skills. Children will explore their local area of Huyton, they will look at known places and plot them on a map. Children will also sort these known places into human and physical features.

Religious Education and World Views

Children will look at how our hands can create things and how people use their hands to help others. They will look closely at hands in Christianity and Hinduism.

Music

Children will learn how to follow beats and rhythm with claps.

PSHE

Children will learn that different families are made up of different people. Consider what friends may be thinking and feeling in different situations, recognise some issues that may occur in friendships, and they may need an adult to help resolve. what different emotions look like and understand that their actions can affect others.

Reading and Phonics

Children will have daily phonics lessons looking closely at sounds and how to read and write these in words. Children will have three opportunities to read with an adult a week, two guided reads and one individual read. This will help to develop fluency
