## English

## The Minpins

Children will begin by engaging in the themes of the story by talking about danger, imagining gruesome consequences if they don't follow instructions! They then go on to read and explore The Minpins and create character descriptions, retellings and eventually writing a new chapter. Here we are

We will look at the themes of family, love, conservation, health and belonging. As the text is shared, children go on to explore the Earth's beauty and use literary language to write some non-narrative poetry.
