

## English

### Wolves

We will explore fact and fiction to help us distinguish what type of wolf character we are dealing with. We will then use our knowledge to write a non-fiction report.

### Tadpoles Promise

Year 2 will be exploring a lovely story with quite the unexpected ending! They will explore and re-enact the story, eventually writing their own.

## Mathematics

### Money

- Count money (pounds and pence)
- Compare amounts
- calculate with money
- Find change

### Multiplication and division

- make and add equal groups
- multiplication symbol
- use arrays
- make equal groups by sharing and grouping
- doubling and halving
- Odd and even numbers
- times and divide by 2, 5 and 10

## French

The children will learn about the French colours, identify fruits and vegetables as well as listening and joining in with stories.

## Physical Education

Dance- to perform dances using simple movement patterns. They will reflect on different styles of dance, influenced by different cultures.

## Science

### Seasons

We will explore the season of Autumn and how it changes our environment and weather. We will collect data to use to compare future seasons.

### Plants

The children will be taught how seeds grow into plants and what plants need to grow. They will identify and describe the basic structure of common plants including trees. Finally, the children will grow their own plants and discuss the changes.

# Spring 1

## Computing

Children will be taught how to be news reporters, exploring sources of news, logos, digital drawings and video clips.

## Music

Musical Vocabulary: children will learn pulse, tempo, pitch, rhythm, texture and structure.

## Art and Design

Sculpture and 3D: Paper Play The children will be learning about 3-D structures. They will roll paper, create 3-D drawings and work as a team to create a giant spider sculpture.

## Geography

Oceans and Continents Children will name some of the World's continents and some of the main oceans. They will be able to recognise visual representations of the World (maps, globes etc..) as being 'the whole World.'

Children understand geographical similarities and differences

## Religious Education and World Views

In Religious Education and World View we will be looking at Forgiveness- What does it mean to belong? Children will learn how Chinese New Year is celebrated. Children will identify why people celebrate Holi. We will also look at what makes a good friend.

## PSHE

Health and Wellbeing The children will learn about the benefits of exercise and relaxation on physical health and wellbeing; strategies to manage different emotions, setting goals and developing a growth mindset and understanding dental hygiene.

## Reading and Phonics

Children will have daily phonics lessons looking closely at sounds and how to read and write these in words. Children will have opportunities to read with an adult during the week, reading in phonics and a guided read. This will help to develop fluency.
