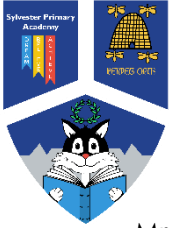

Victorian Toys

Do you know what toys the children of rich Victorians played with? There were no plastic toys, no computers and certainly no DVD players.

Did you know that rich children often had their own large playrooms? The playroom was often well away from their parents at the top of the house. Young children were to be seen but not heard. Most little children had a nanny (governess) who would look after them. Some of the most popular toys were train sets, wooden soldiers, rocking horses, pretty dolls, teddy bears and board games. Children were not allowed to play with toys on Sundays however they could read the Bible.
