PSHE	<p>Metacognition and Growth Mind-set</p> <p>Have a think about a time when you have felt something was too difficult or when you have wanted to 'give up'</p> <p><i>How did you overcome this feeling/problem? Who helped you? What did you do to get better or improve?</i></p> <p>When you have a 'Growth Mind-set' you become comfortable with challenge and understand that failing is just part of learning. When you have a Fixed Mind-set', you give up easily and tell yourself that challenges are impossible.</p> <p>Create a poster to illustrate the different between a growth mind-set and a fixed mind-set.
